Vietnam Memorial Project

In the mid 1990's the Vancouver Chapter of Vietnam Veterans of America started a project to remember the fallen and missing men and women of the Vietnam War from Clark County. Black anodized plaques, each with a name of one of the 62 fallen and missing in

Vietnam only were built to display at a not yet secured sight. A location would be needed that would not be vulnerable to vandalism and theft.

The project was put on hold and the plaques put into storage.

Now, some 20 years later, a small group of veterans has received permission from the Veterans Administration to erect a memorial on their Vancouver VA campus on the west side under the UH-1B "Huey" named Lady Bell

In order to accomplish this memorial to the fallen and missing, we are asking for your tax deductible donations for the construction of the memorial.
