Benches 2

Five polished concrete benches represent the five branches of the military: Army, Navy, Marines, Air Force, and the Coast Guard. Each bench will have an embedded plague dedicated to one of the military branches.



Entry Sign ①

The entry sign welcomes visitors to the memorial and serves as a visual and acoustical barrier to traffic on 4th street. The rounded arch shape mimics the memorial wall in the background. Ledgestone adds texture and interest while the sign lettering stands out in polished stainless steel.

Flowering Cherry Trees 6

Flowering cherries ring the memorial and provide a backdrop to the memorial wall. Their low spreading nature will not overpower the memorial and offers four-seasonal interest.





Permeable Pavers 7

Permeable pavers reduce water runoff as well as as provide an opportunity for engraving additional names. The textural difference from the surrounding paving materials slows the visitor as they enter the space.
