The 2015 parade will be in the Felida Park only. Follow the leader of the parade (banner)) and signs. Parade ends by after-parade activity areas -- edge of south soccer field, by the picnic shelter donated by the community to Clark County. March to live performance of the Vancouver Community Concert Band.
