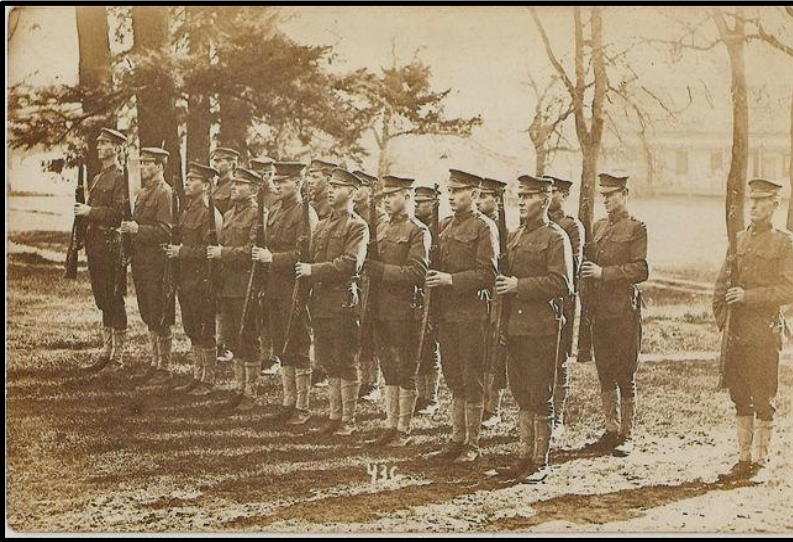

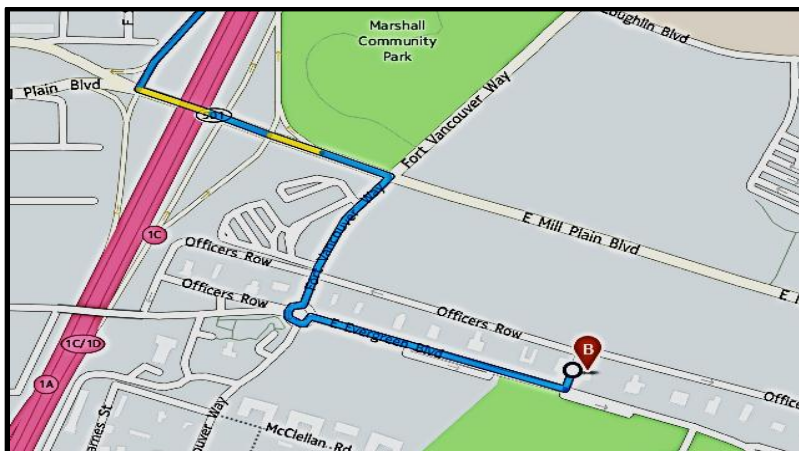

Since it was established in 1849, authorities at the Vancouver Barracks needed to detain people for various reasons, some justified, some for the sake of expediency. This included deserters, Native Americans, Confederate sympathizers, criminals, and a supposed anarchist. Learn more about sometimes tragic, sometimes

humorous stories of prisoners at the Vancouver Barracks Guard House.
