• Dan Sockle introduced Art Liss, with "The Rescue at Cau Song Be" whose brother (CPT) Larry Liss and another pilot, (CWO) Tom Baca, on 14 May 1967, transformed their unarmed VIP flight into an extraction mission that saved about 80 South Vietnamese soldiers surrounded by an estimated 600 or so NVN and VC in the final days of "Operation Junction City." Both received Distinguished Flying Crosses, as did another pilot in a second Huey – efforts now ongoing to reach out to Special Forces survivors.
